Hi Cathy:

It was a pleasure speaking with you this morning. As agreed, I am following up on the information we discussed.

- (1) The number of signs is still being considered. We understand and agree that New Hanover County is better suited to make the final decision regarding the number of signs. To assist you in making that decision, I attached a map to this message that illustrates the inferred area of groundwater discharge (based on surface water and groundwater monitoring results). The bolded, hatched line is the unnamed tributary. I circled the concentrations that I used to mark the length of area requiring signage (blue circles). The bold green line shows the length of tributary impacted by water quality issues. The signs are cautionary for residents and trespassers. Although there is some discharge onsite property, our focus is not on the adult workers, but on offsite residential adults and children.

If this map is too small to be useful to you, let me know and I'll try to find a larger version of this same thing. The problem is that no single figure illustrates everything I need.

- (2) The minimum sign size should be equivalent to a "No Parking" sign. I measured that at 18" in width by 24" in length.
- (3) A single sign post will be installed at each location. One sign in English will be placed on the sign post (in accordance with the mockup we all agreed on). A second sign in Spanish will be hung below it. Signs will be placed on ONE side of the post (not both sides) in the most visible fashion possible.
- (4) The signs will be posted on public utility property and New Hanover will work with its contacts to obtain the necessary right-of-access agreements.
- (5) Once everything is agreed upon and the cost of the signs/installation is known, I will reach out to Daikin to obtain the required funding.
