I just received the Screening Report that provides an idea of the number of non-English speaking individuals in a given area. The report estimates that ~3 percent of the population in the area highlighted on page 1 of the attached document speak English “less than very well.” Zero percent speak Spanish.

I don't know if this report will influence your decision regarding the signs, but I am passing it on to you for your records.
