2. The Septage Land Application Site consists of Field 1 with 5.9 acres and Field 2 with 6.9 acres for a total of 12.8 acres.

- 3. The site is permitted for land application of domestic septage and portable toilet waste.
- 4. The site is located on Union Church Rd. (SR-1364) and has accessible all-weather roads to the septage land application field covered under the permit.
- 5. Some of the disposal area boundary markers between Fields 1 and 2 were missing. These will need to be replaced.**
- 6. All septage discharges appear to have been made within the disposal area boundary. No recent septage application were observed.
- 7. No evidence of standing liquid or pooled waste was observed. The waste appeared to be evenly distributed throughout the field.
- 8. No objectionable odors were observed.
- 9. The crop appeared to have been recently harvested.
- 10. Appropriate signage was displayed at the entrance.
