PUBLIC NOTICE

July 14th, 2016

Veolia ES Technical Solutions, L.L.C. (Veolia), located at 2176 Will Suitt Road in Creedmoor, NC is required by certain provisions of Session Law 2007-107 as amended by Session Law 2007-495 to annually publish a notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the community where it is located. The notice must include the location of the facility, a description of the facility, the hazardous and non-hazardous waste that are received and processed at the facility and a description of the emergency response plan for the facility.

Veolia is an environmental services company that conducts waste management operations at the corner location of State Routes 1104 and 1106 (Will Suitt Road and East Lyon Station) in Butner, North Carolina. The mailing address of the facility is 2176 Will Suitt Road, Creedmoor, NC 27522.

Veolia specializes in the packing, handling and transportation of hazardous and non-hazardous waste. In providing these services, hazardous and non-hazardous waste are temporarily stored at this location. There are no waste treatment or disposal activities conducted at this location. All waste materials are packaged in appropriate containers and temporarily stored in trailers at a loading dock. The loading dock area is designed with an extensive secondary containment system to prevent the escape of waste material into the environment in the unlikely event of a release. The facility also meets the established federal and state standards for security and fire prevention and is inspected 6 (six) times per month by state regulatory compliance personnel.

The waste that Veolia manages generally falls into two broad categories: (1) packaged laboratory chemicals and (2) containerized liquids and solids. Some of these waste are classified as hazardous waste due to the chemical properties they exhibit (ignitable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic) or because they meet a specific listing according to Federal or State regulation. Some examples of the common wastes managed by Veolia that are generated by local businesses include discarded paints, cleaning solutions, batteries, mercury-containing lamps, and off-specification industrial or consumer products.

In the event of an emergency, Veolia has developed and maintains a comprehensive emergency and contingency plan. The North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources (NCDENR) and the Local Emergency Planning Commission (LEPC) have approved this plan. Veolia communicates with the local emergency service providers on an ongoing basis to assure that the safety of community residents are addressed in an unlikely event of an emergency.

Dear Mr. Beck:

North Carolina General Statute 130A-295.01(e) requires that permit holders for a commercial hazardous waste facility shall annually publish a notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the community where the facility is located. The notice must include the location of the facility, a description of the facility, the hazardous and non-hazardous wastes that are received and processed at the facility and a description of the emergency response plan for the facility. The notice shall be in a form and manner approved by the Hazardous Waste Section. In addition, the facility must provide documentation to demonstrate that this requirement has been met. On the reverse of this letter is an excerpt from the General Statute.

Veolia must publish the notice no later than July 24. Veolia must provide the proposed text and the name of the newspaper to the Hazardous Waste Section for review no later than July 1, 2016.

1) Within 10 days of filing an application for a permit for a commercial hazardous waste facility, the applicant shall notify every person who resides or owns property located within one-fourth mile of any property boundary of the facility that the application has been filed. The notice shall be by mail to residents and by certified mail to property owners, or by any other means approved by the Department, shall be in a form approved by the Department, and shall include all of the following:

- (a) The location of the facility.
- (b) A description of the facility.
- (c) The hazardous and nonhazardous wastes that are to be received and processed at the facility.
- (d) A description of the emergency response plan for the facility.

2) **The permit holder for a commercial hazardous waste facility shall publish a notice that includes the information set out in subdivision (1) of this subsection annually beginning one year after the permit is issued. The notice shall be published in a form and manner approved by the Department in a newspaper of general circulation in the community where the facility is located.**

- 3) The permit holder for a commercial hazardous waste facility shall provide the information set out in subdivision (1) of this subsection by mail to the persons described in subdivision (1) of this subsection at the midpoint of the period for which the permit is issued.
- 4) Each commercial hazardous waste facility applicant and permit holder shall provide documentation to demonstrate to the Department that the requirements set out in subdivisions (1), (2), and (3) of this subsection have been met.
