



Lead contaminated waste will be generated during a project for the renovation of windows at the NC State Capitol, a registered historic property. The project is anticipated to start on April 1, 2016 and be completed on or about September 30, 2016. Window sashes are being removed and taken to the Enpuricon, Inc. site in Apex, NC for paint stabilization, wood repair and repainting. The frames are being renovated in place by the removal of loose and flaking paint, repairs as necessary and repainting. The waste being generated, including paint chips, the worker's protective clothing and the plastic sheeting used to contain work areas, has been tested by TCLP and found to meet the definition of a hazardous waste.

14. Certification.
