

FIT 4 conducted Phase I of a Screening Site Inspection of Southeastern Pollution Control in Pineville, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina. This assessment included a review of EPA and state file material and an attempt to locate the facility.

Southeastern Pollution Control operated a liquid and solid waste transportation and disposal business and consulting service allegedly in the Pineville area. According to Mecklenburg County officials, the business was located in Pineville and had business ties with the Fort Lawn Landfill in South Carolina. Waste was brought to the Pineville facility in 55-gallon drums, temporarily stored in a shed, then transported to the landfill for disposal. The landfill was closed in 1981 because of contamination of wells in the area. At this time, Southeastern Pollution Control also ceased operations (Ref. 1).

A Potential Hazardous Waste Site Identification and Preliminary Assessment form was completed in 1980. This form stated that the facility was identified in the Eckard Report. It also said that its owner was Mobile Oil in South Carolina (Ref. 2).

In 1986, attempts were made to locate the facility by the North Carolina Department of Human Resources; however, nobody was sure of its exact location (Ref. 1). It is possible that the facility was actually located in South Carolina, across the border from Pineville (Ref. 3). They did not have a deed filed between the years of 1978 - 1981 in Mecklenburg County, nor a business license in Pineville (Refs. 4, 5).

Another attempt was made to locate this facility from November 1989 to January 1990. A reconnaissance of the area was conducted January 18-19, 1990. The following offices had no records of this business in their files: Raleigh, North Carolina, Hazardous Waste Management; South Carolina, Department of Health and Quality; United States Environmental Protection Agency; North

Carolina, Department of Transportation; Secretary of State's Office, South Carolina; and South Carolina Tax Commission (Refs. 6, 7, 8, 9, 10). Additionally, it did not have any listing as a RCRA facility (Ref. 11). Since Mobile Oil of South Carolina was listed as an owner, an attempt was made to find it under this name, too. South Carolina had only one listing for Mobile Oil in Greenville (Ref. 10). As the only address in the files was from the Pineville post office, the post office was contacted to see if there had been a billing address. Postal workers remembered the name of the company, but do not keep records of past customers (Refs. 10, 12). Several people in the Pineville area were questioned about the company with no success (Ref. 10).

Mecklenburg County telephone books from 1960 to 1986 were reviewed. There was a listing for Southeastern Pollution Control, Charlotte Highway in Clover, South Carolina for 1971 (Ref. 13). Therefore, an attempt was made to locate this business in this area. Several people believed that a site on the Charlotte Highway, 1.1 mile south of the North Carolina border, was associated with Southeastern Pollution Control (Ref. 10). This site was involved in an emergency cleanup by EPA; however, Fred Stroud of the EPA said that it had no connection with Southeastern (Refs. 10, 14).

Although John Gibson of the Mecklenburg County Department of Environmental Management did not remember the location of Southeastern, he said that the Pineville site was a drop-off point with a telephone, not a disposal site. The actual location was in Fort Lawn, South Carolina (Ref. 15).

Since the location for Southeastern Pollution Control could not be identified, it is recommended that there be no further remedial action planned for this facility. It is also felt that evidence for the site's location indicates that it is actually located in South Carolina, not North Carolina. Enclosed please find the Preliminary Assessment report for the subject site. This priority is based on review of available data.

Southeastern Pollution Control was located in Pineville, NC and operated at that site for approximately three years; roughly between the years of 1978 and 1981.

Southeastern Pollution Control operated a sales oriented type of liquid and solid waste transportation and disposal business. The company also operated a business consulting service at the Pineville site. According to Mecklenburg County officials, the business office was located in Pineville, NC and the company had ties (they are unsure of the nature) with the Fort Lawn Landfill in SC. Personnel for the company visited area businesses to obtain contracts for the removal and disposal of liquid and solid waste. The 55-gallon drums of waste were brought to the Pineville facility by company personnel and temporarily stored in an outside shed on the site. The waste was placed on concrete pads inside the shed. When the company obtained approximately two truck loads of waste, the waste was taken to the Fort Lawn Landfill in South Carolina for disposal. This landfill was a large in-ground unlined trench. Liquid and solid waste were landfilled here. Around 1981 the landfill was closed by the State of South Carolina, because of drinking water contamination in the nearby wells. The wells were contaminated with high levels of organics. Shortly after the landfill closure, Southeastern Pollution Control became defunct.

Mecklenburg County officials visited the facility only once during operations. They are unsure of the location of the past owner or the location of the site. Telephone calls to the business licensing offices for Charlotte and Pineville proved futile. They have no records of the company ever operating in the City of Pineville.

Because the facility cannot currently be located, No Further Action is recommended for this site.

On 2 June 1986, this Preliminary Assessment was reviewed by CERCLA Unit personnel and by the following representatives from the North Carolina Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Environmental Management: Glenn Ross, Air Quality Section; Vince Schneider and Howard Bryant, Water Quality Section.
