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

EPA has identified the Brownfields Initiative as one of the Agency's top priorities. The term "brownfields" refers to previously used properties that may lie vacant because potential contamination makes them unmarketable to the private sector. EPA has recently announced a comprehensive Brownfields strategy, including Pilot grants to municipalities, to stimulate economic revitalization.

One part of the strategy has been for EPA to review its complete inventory of Superfund sites. These sites have been screened and determined to require no remedial action under the Federal Superfund Program based on information available as well as on conditions and policies that currently exist. This is to notify you that EPA has removed your facility from EPA's computer inventory known as CERCLIS. THIS DOES NOT INDICATE THAT THE STATE HAS MADE A SIMILAR DETERMINATION.


Dear Mr. Nicholson:

Submitted herewith is the Preliminary Assessment Report for the subject site. The priority for inspection is based on our review of available data and on conversations with site owners and site operators.

This site was a J. P. Stevens weaving facility from about 1953 until 1983. Although an application for interim status as a TSD was apparently filed, the company reportedly did not routinely generate hazardous wastes. Some wastes, such as boiler water chemicals, oils, and hydraulic fluids, were probably produced on-site. Reportedly, the plant discharged most wastes into the Randleman sewer system. There was an NPDES discharge of boiler blowdown water into the Deep River. The NC Division of Environmental Management, Water Quality Section reports that there were no violations of the NPDES permit, however. A company official reports that there were no landfills or burials of wastes on the site.

On November 17, 1983, in response to a formal call for part B of a permit application, an officer of your company advised this Branch that a part B application would not be filed. Following this, on January 29, 1984 and February 1, 1984, the Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Waste Management Branch of the Department of Human Resources published a legal notice in the Raleigh papers, announcing its intention to deny a permit and terminate interim status for a number of plants, including yours.

You are now advised that this plant has been denied a permit as a hazardous waste treatment, storage, or disposal facility and its interim status has been formally terminated. As of March 30, 1984, the operators of it may not treat or dispose of hazardous waste, nor store it for more than 90 days from the of accumulation.

Water Supply Calculation

The surface water use within three miles of the site consists of the town of Randleman's intake which is 1.1 miles east of the site. The water system serves 2500 people.

All water sources within three miles of the site except for the Randleman system are groundwater sources. Based on the 1980 census, there is a population density of 116 people per square mile in Randolph County. A three mile diameter circle contains 28.27 square miles. The population within a three mile diameter circle is 3279 people (116 people per square mile times 28.27 square miles). Surface water is used by 2500 of these people, so 779 people use groundwater. Based on a measurement from a USGS topographic map, the nearest house not within the city limits (and presumably using a well for a water source) is 2300 feet from the site.

Water supply in area

On 12 August 1987, I spoke via telephone with Bob Allred, Water Plant Operator for Randleman, and on 13 August 1987, I spoke via telephone with Coy Thorton, Water Plant Operator for Randleman. The telephone number for both is (919) 498-2352. They both furnished the following information.

The Randleman system supplies water to 2500 people with water from a surface source only. The intake is on a small lake on Polecat Creek. The system serves only those residents inside the main city limits, inside the limits of the satellite of Randleman, and inside portions of the annexed community of Worthville. Parts of Worthville are still served by community wells. The Randleman distribution system is connected to the Asheboro system with a 12-inch diameter water main paralleling US 220 (Business). The connection between the two systems is valved and metered. Randleman uses the water from Asheboro only during emergency water shortages. There are no known county water systems, or other community water systems serving the area outside the Randleman city limits. Private wells are the predominant water source for this area.

On 12 August 1987, I spoke via telephone with Randy Macon, Water Plant Supervisor for Asheboro, (919) 626-1215. He supplied the following information.


Asheboro's primary water source is Lake Lucas on Back Creek; their secondary source is Lake Reese on the Uwharrie River; and they occasionally use water from lakes Ross, Bunch, and McCrary. All the lakes are two to three miles west of Asheboro. The water distribution system for Asheboro lies entirely within the city limits except for a small area outside to the northwest. No water is supplied to residents within three miles of the J.P. Stevens facility in Randleman. A 12-inch diameter water main connects the Asheboro system to the Randleman system and is used by Randleman only during water shortages. The connection is valved and metered and is not regularly used.

As a result of the discussions with the water system operators of Randleman and of Asheboro, the limits of the water distribution systems and the surface water intakes for the two cities were plotted on the topographic map.

I spoke over the telephone with Sam Griggs, the Corporate Director of the Environmental Affairs Department for J.P. Stevens Corporation, (803) 239-4196. He told me the following:

The J.P. Stevens plant in Randleman was used for 25 to 30 years prior to being sold in 1983. The plant was acquired by J.P. Stevens from Carter Textiles.

The plant was a weaving facility which did not routinely generate hazardous wastes.

Boiler water treatment chemicals, waste oils, and waste hydraulic fluids were sometimes generated.

The plant withdrew water from the Deep River, treated it, and used it for cooling water (and perhaps other uses). The plant used the Randleman sewer system for its wastes.

NC Division of Environmental Management issued the plant a permit to discharge into the river.

Mr. Griggs knows of no burials or disposals of hazardous wastes on-site.

I spoke over the telephone with Ms. Linda Moore, City Clerk and Finance Director for Randleman, (919) 498-2604. She was familiar with the site and helped me locate it on the topographic map. She said that the building was now used by Vogue/Albert Martin Company, (919) 498-4101.

I spoke over the telephone with Ms. Donna Yaniglos, the bookkeeper for Vogue/Albert Martin, (919) 498-4101. She told me that the property owner is now Jeff Schwarz, PO Box 1104, Asheboro, NC 27203, and that the present tenant is Sam Blount Company, Inc. doing business as Vogue/Albert Martin Company. The company makes rattan furniture. She also said that Mr. Jay Shaw, the Controller, or Mr. Kim Crossman, the General Manager, could probably tell me more about the site. She will have Mr. Shaw call me later today.



MEAN ANNUAL PRECIPITATION AND MEAN ANNUAL EVAPORATION


