7. FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The Chief Feed Mill is located next to the Rosemary Mill. The Chief
is the larger mill and is responsible for producing feed for finished or adult hogs. The site has an air
quality permit as well as a storm water prevention permit. There are 25 regular employees and 31
temps.


- **Universal Waste:** The facility generates used lamps. Ms. Elmer stated all lamps are disposed
in the landfill because a determination has been made that they are non-hazardous. Page 2 of

the facility's environmental management manual (MB 023) states, "Fluorescent lamps that are identified as low mercury content can be disposed of in solid waste (trash)..." I explained to Ms. Elmer the need to have supporting analytical data from the lamp manufacturer if such a broad policy is in place. No lamps were observed on site during this inspection.

- **Used Oil:** Used oil is occasionally generated from equipment maintenance. Typically, used oil is not accumulated on site. If used oil is ever generated on site, be certain to labeled with the words "used oil."

10. RECOMMENDATIONS: Contact the Division of Environmental Assistance and Customer Service (DEACS) to locate a viable option for e-waste recycling.
