<b>DISCUSSION:</b>	
<p>Judy said that WK Dickson had been contracted by the Town to help them with land acquisition for their runway extension. They had found several properties with unregistered USTs. There was soil contamination present but they had been working with Michele Croot (UST Section) and she had said that since the soil would be covered by the runway, they could register it with the Register of Deeds and wouldn't have to do anymore work. Judy assumed that my letter had to do with that. I said it didn't, it was actually related to the TCE that had been detected in the supply well up by the airplane hangars. I explained that while the TCE was not currently above the 2L, the source was unknown and the levels in the well had been increasing. So I had had to issue the new site letter. I said the TCE may be related to activities conducted within the hangars, but I had issued the letter to the Town because they were the property owners and it notified them that it was a new site. Judy said that they will help the Town put together an appropriate response and the questionnaire.</p>
