Dear Mr. McMillan:

Upon a recent review of our files, our office found that we do not have the ground water and surface water analytical data for the 1989 sampling episode at the Alleghany County Landfill. Landfill Owner/Operators are required to send the Solid Waste Section copies of the analytical data on a yearly basis. This analytical data is comprised of laboratory results from samples extracted from the ground-water monitoring wells and the surface water sampling locations.

If the 1989 sampling has been done, please send copies of the results to this office within the next 15 days. If the 1989 sampling was not done, you should schedule a sampling event within the next 30 days. The proper sampling procedures and parameters are documented in the North Carolina Water Quality Monitoring Guidance Document For Solid Waste Facilities. Copies of the sample results should be forwarded to the Solid Waste Section within 15 days upon receipt by your office.
