Dear Mr. MacWilliams:

This e-mail serves as a courtesy reminder regarding the upcoming remedial investigation deadline. A Registered Environmental Consultant (REC) Administrative Agreement (AA) was executed for the above referenced site on **June 4, 2010**. As indicated in the AA and the REC Rules, the remedial investigation must be completed at the site within three years of the effective date of the agreement. Therefore, all field activities for the remedial investigation must be complete and the findings included in a certified final remedial investigation report, including properly completed work-phase completion statement(s), on or before **June 4, 2013**.

As a general reminder, failing to meet deadlines is a violation of the REC Program rules. The AA between the Remediating Party (RP) and the Division may be dissolved and the site transferred from the Responsible Party Voluntary Remedial Action category to the Sites Priority List category of the Inactive Hazardous Sites Inventory. In some cases, the RP and REC for these sites may also be subject to enforcement action if there is potential for public harm. Please review the AA, REC Rules, and the REC Implementation Guidance for additional information.
