<p>Greg is with the Mohawk Industries headquarters in Calhoun/Dalton, GA. He will be at the plant on Tuesday. He said that he was trying to find out what was going on at the site. I told him that we had received very specific complaints about ongoing spills and leaks. I wrote my letter in response to the complaint to give Mohawk a chance to provide more info. I have received a response from the plant manager, but unfortunately it wasn't specific enough to address the complaint, so I need to see the plant to decide what to do next. Greg said that the plant recently shut down its third shift and had to lay off a number of workers. They think it is a disgruntled employee. I told him that we have encountered that before, but that we have also encountered many manufacturing plants that actually do have problems, so we have to check it out. Greg asked if I had been in contact with WaRO. I told him that I knew that they had also received the complaint and had involved Greenville Utilities, but their focus is the wastewater treatment and possible affects to surface water. Our primary concerns are soil and groundwater. He asked where I was out of and I told him that we are out of Wilmington. Our group doesn't have same regional divides as other sections, we only have 2 regions, east and west and anyone in east can be assigned to any site in the eastern region. Greg said that they would have their paper work ready for me when I come on Tuesday. I told him that the paper work that I would be interested in would soil and groundwater sampling results, manifests from soil removal related to spill cleanup or other stuff like that. He said that a UST had been removed fairly recently and they should have some documentation related to that. I said okay, I will see him on Tuesday.</p>
