The address for the influent & effluent samples referenced in your last email are for the Rickman Residence at 322 VFW Road. I have also attached the sampling results for the Cook Residence located at 328 VFW Road. The collection of the potable water samples and the methods used to analyze the samples were performed in accordance with S&ME Proposal No. P131-12V dated October 9, 2012.

Potable water samples were collected from a point of entry drinking water system located at 328 VFW Road, Reidsville, North Carolina, following the procedures as described in our proposal. The samples were shipped to Test America Laboratories and analyzed by US EPA Method 508.

The samples are labeled “influent,” “effluent” and “method blank.” This report begins at page 393 of the third file, described as “Sample Events and POE Installs.” Can you tell me the property address from which these samples were taken? The address is not apparent from the report. It would also be helpful if you could mark the influent and effluent sample points on an aerial.
