MECKLENBURG COUNTY
SOLID WASTE FEE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Mecklenburg County adopted an ordinance entitled "Mecklenburg County Solid Waste Fee Ordinance" effective July 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Mecklenburg County now desires to amend said Ordinance; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, that:

1. The "Mecklenburg County Solid Waste Fee Ordinance" is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Fee Schedule

It shall be unlawful for any vehicle, except as otherwise provided herein, to enter and to use any solid waste disposal facility owned and/or operated by Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, except upon the payment of the following fees:

(a) When the scales/weighing systems are in operation, fees shall be computed as follows:

<u>Vehicle Type</u>	<u>Charge</u>	<u>Recycling Exemption</u>
(1) Automobiles *	\$ 6.00 per load	3 bags
(2) Trailers (less than 10 ft. single axle, household waste) *	\$12.00 per load	6 bags
Vans (one ton or less, household waste) *	\$12.00 per load	6 bags
Pickups (one ton or less, household waste) *	\$12.00 per load	6 bags
(3) Pickups, Vans, Trailers, (less than 10 ft., one ton or less, non-household waste) *	\$24.00 per load	75%
(4) All permitted vehicles	\$29.50 per ton/or \$24.00 per load minimum	75%
(5) All other vehicle types	\$29.50 per ton/or \$24.00 per load minimum	75%

NOTE: * Non-Permitted Vehicles

(b) When the scales/weighing systems are not in operation, fees shall be computed as follows:

<u>Vehicle Type</u>	<u>Charge</u>	<u>Recycling Exemption</u>
(1) Automobiles *	\$ 6.00 per load	3 bags
(2) Trailers (less than 10 ft. single axle, household waste) *	\$12.00 per load	6 bags
(3) Vans or Pickups (one ton or less, household waste) *	\$12.00 per load	6 bags
(4) Vans, Pickups, Trailers, (less than 10 ft., single axle, 1 ton or less non-household waste)	\$24.00 per load	75%
(5) Trucks, small, open (greater than 1 ton, less than 3 ton capacity)	\$44.00 per load	75%
(6) Compactor Rear loading, Front loading, Roll-off Container, Roll-off Container open top	\$ 7.70 per cubic yard vehicle capacity	75%
(7) Van, commercial	\$ 4.50 per linear foot of cargo body	75%
(8) Trailer, commercial Closed or Open	\$ 4.50 per linear foot of cargo body	75%
(9) Truck, Dump or Flat Bed, tandem axle	\$77.00 per load \$122.00 per load	75%

NOTE: * Non-Permitted Vehicles

2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioners that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the Board of Commissioners without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional or invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

3. This amended and restated Ordinance shall be effective from and after the first day of July, 1991.
