

Spoke with Judy Mall of the office of State Representative Danny McCommis who had been contacted by Penny Myers, daughter of Gordon Haught of Atkinson St. Ms. Myers had contacted the state representative office to see if they could help with fixing the well contamination problem.

I explained how the contamination was detected as part of the sampling associated with the peach tree orchard, what the concentrations were and the amount of well sampling that had taken place.

I briefly covered surrounding supply well sampling and the assessment work performed by the IHSB through the orphan contract and the voluntary work that CSX had performed. I explained that no link was ascertained between CSX and Mr. Haughts well.

No RP or source for the 1,1 DCE has conclusively been established. I explained that Mr. Haught is being provided bottled water and that he is using rain barrels and getting water from his neighbor for his garden.

We discussed the \$500,000 estimate that was given to extend public water to Mr. Haught and that local govt. had no budget to perform such action and was very unlikely to ever happen. We discussed a possible POE system and the cost to maintain such a system that would have to borne by Mr. Haught. I discussed that we are exploring the option of drilling a well in a new location and the major concerns we have for doing so. (paying to re-drill a well), no guarantee that the new well would not also be contaminated.

I cautioned that Re-drilling a well is just an option being looked at and should be construed no other way.
