Dear Mr. Hawks:

This will confirm our conversation of yesterday concerning the open solid waste dump on Garcia Kennedy Road. It is my understanding from observation of this waste and conversation with you, that the waste was collected at your produce stand at 1436 National Highway, transported to Garcia Kennedy Road, and dumped.

The site on Garcia Kennedy Road is not approved for solid waste disposal in accordance with the Division of Health Services' "Solid Waste Management Rules." It was agreed that all solid waste must be removed from this location not later than September 13, 1978.

The Holly Grove landfill and several container sites are approved solid waste disposal locations provided by the county.

The "Solid Waste Management Rules", section .0104, refer to proper solid waste storage. Waste at your business was not stored properly at the time of my inspection. It was agreed that this violation would also be corrected prior to September 13, 1978.

Your prompt attention to correcting the violations referred to above will be appreciated. If this office may provide additional information, please call.

On July 12, 1977 Mr. Sidney R. Lyle, Sanitarian Supervisor Davidson County, and I inspected a solid waste disposal site near the Wallburg-High Point Road in Davidson County. It is my understanding that you own this disposal facility.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that this site is not planned, operated, or approved in accordance with the Division of Health Services "Solid Waste Management Rules". Use of the site must be discontinued, effective immediately. Not later than August 20, 1977, the site must be closed in accordance with Section .0123 "Nonconforming Sites and Facilities", of the State Solid Waste Management Rules.

It is requested that you notify this office as soon as closure is complete so that an inspection can be scheduled.
