HOW WAS THE FIRE REPORTED AND BY WHOM:

Smoking ashes was reported by Johnny Burgess to Stephen King. Stephen left a message with Lee Hill on his Office phone but later called his cell and spoke directly to him. After that the Haywood County Sheriff department was contacted to file a report of illegal dumping of hot ashes.

LIST ACTIONS TAKEN:

Waste was isolated and sprayed down with water until it was no longer smoking. Waste was left on floor over drain.

WHAT WAS THE CAUSE OF THE FIRE:

Hot Ashes

DESCRIBE AREA, TYPE, AND AMOUNT OF WASTE INVOLVED:

Waste and ashes were unloaded from a trash can (50 gallon container) onto the tipping floor.

WHAT COULD HAVE BEEN DONE TO PREVENT THIS FIRE:

I am not aware of anything else we could have done to prevent this from happening. Proper steps were taken right away. Johnny noticed the material had ashes and he stopped the man from dumping anymore material. A sign is posted about not accepting ashes. We isolated the material and sprayed water onto the material.
