Dear Mr. Cleveland:

Cabarrus County, North Carolina requests EPA assistance through the Technical Assistance Panel Program in conducting a study of possible resource recovery methods at the county sanitary landfill. The county is primarily interested in pursuing a plan for energy recovery from waste and would like assistance in deciding on the direction the County should take with resource recovery.

Initially we would need roughly two to three man-days of assistance to determine feasible methods of resource recovery for Cabarrus County. Some subsequent technical assistance in acquiring grants or loans, and engineering assistance might be needed at a future time.

Cabarrus County is located in the Piedmont of North Carolina with a population of approximately 80,000. Solid waste collection in the county is by franchise and municipal back yard pick-up. The county run sanitary landfill receives approximately 200 tons of solid waste a day. The landfill is located about seven (7) miles from Concord and Kannapolis, the main areas of population density.


Any technical assistance that you could provide would be greatly appreciated.



Thank you for allowing me to speak with you regarding the open dump on your property on Haywood Avenue.

To confirm our P.M. conversation, this office requests your immediate action on closing the refuse dump located in front of your home on Haywood Avenue.

Removing all household and/or commercial waste will require rat baiting and depositing the waste in the State approved Cabarrus County Sanitary Landfill.

On-site burial of the waste will require rat baiting, compaction of waste, two feet cover and seeding to prevent erosion.

Please notify Mr. Everett Galloway, Sanitarian Supervisor, Cabarrus County Health Department, upon compliance.
