Dear Mr. Corbitt:

Thank you for your November 19, 2014 response to my September 25, 2014 audit letter for the Goldsboro Milling-Mill #1 & #2 facility (Site). My audit Letter revealed several deficiencies in your Remedial Investigation (RI) Work Plan, dated September 24, 2013. Ensuring the work conducted is clearly documented for the public and Branch is important for the independent cleanups in the REC Program. Please make sure future work phases, plans and reports address the components of the REC Rules.

In your response, you provided the requested information in the form of seven maps. The site maps differed slightly from the site maps presented in the Remedial Investigation Work Plan, but the requested information was adequately shown. As I mentioned in our phone conversation on December 2, 2014, the final site map presented in the RI report should have all wells, buildings and structures professionally surveyed [see 15A NCAC 13C .0306(g)(4) for the specific requirements].

Because the property has a number of water supply wells in the vicinity of the Site, they should be identified and their use discussed in the RI report. As the remedial investigation reveals the extent of contamination, any threats to water supply wells should be closely monitored as the assessment progresses. If any water supply wells become impacted by Site contaminants then the Branch must be notified [see .0305(b)(1) and (2)].
