Just an update;

- 1) The onsite sentinel wells have been installed. MW-28 was dry at approx. 100 ft bgs; a second attempt offset 20 feet towards MW-12 also returned dry at approx. 75 feet so we stopped drilling at that location. The other well installations were successful.
- 2) We will wait to install the additional off-site wells (near MW-5/16) after we receive permission from the current property owner or the County purchases the property.
- 3) We revised our EOS calculations and met with our proposed injector at the site to finalize logistics for the injection at both locations and finish those sections of the UIC application. We discussed the pros/cons of installing the injection wells while we wait for application approval.
- 4) We talked with Thomas Slusser (UIC) regarding the most efficient application submittal since we are proposing different injections (a barrier wall at MW-5/16, and a single-point source well located between MW-11 and MW-26) on the same site. He agreed to a combined application. We didn't discuss his current backlog or anticipated review/approval schedule but indicated the application would be submitted by Friday.
