The Solid Waste Section has reviewed the *Corrective Action Extension Request - Land Use Restrictions and Preparation of a Survey Plat Map* dated July 6, 2011 (Doc ID 14317) submitted on behalf of Alexander County by Municipal Engineering Services Co., P.A. for the Alexander County C&D Over MSW Landfill. The Solid Waste Section approved the County's *Corrective Action Plan* on February 19, 2009 that included the implementation of Monitored Natural Attenuation (MNA), Phytoremediation, Enhanced Bioremediation (using an edible oil substrate), Active Methane Extraction System, and Acquisition of Property. Within the *Corrective Action Plan*, the County inquired about extending the landfill's relevant point of compliance for groundwater quality onto the newly acquired property, and in order for the Solid Waste Section to evaluate this request, a letter was issued to the County dated April 15, 2011 requesting the submittal of specific deeds, permits, and other recorded instruments.

Therefore, the County is requesting a 30 day extension from the end of the original 90 day period to submit the requested information. As a result, the request is approved as described.
