Subject: Mount Herman Landfill Greenhouse Gas Project

Dear Mr. Frost:

Per the approval letter issued by NCDENR – Division of Waste Management on October 15, 2008 for the Mt. Herman Landfill (Permit No. 14-01), I am writing to inform you of the schedule for the second phase of the construction for the installation of the lateral and header piping that will connect the vertical gas wells to the existing flare at the Mt. Herman Landfill.

SCS Field Services will mobilize to the site on Monday, February 16 and commence construction activities on February 17. Waste generated from the installation of the lateral and header piping systems will be placed in roll-off containers and disposed of in the Foothills Municipal Solid Waste Landfill. SCS expects that construction will be completed within a two week period and the only remaining construction activity will be the installation of an advanced landfill gas flow rate and continuous methane monitoring system which should occur in early April.

After completion of the gas collection system, SCS will conduct a survey of the system and provide as-built drawings of the landfill gas collection system to you.
