Dear Mr. Page:

In previous communication regarding the LCID landfill, you expressed the intent to close the site. The following procedures are necessary to formally begin the closure process.


1. Within 14 days of the receipt of this letter, submit a signed and dated letter to the Solid Waste Section (SWS) explaining that disposal operations have ceased, the landfill is inactive, and that you intend to close. Within the letter, provide for SWS review and approval a schedule for meeting requirements in Items 2-4 below.
2. Submit to the SWS a letter of certification, signed by a North Carolina licensed professional engineer, that a minimum of one (1) foot of suitable soil cover has been placed over the entire landfill. The engineer should take soil borings to determine thickness of the final cover. Soil borings should be on a grid, spaced every 50 to 75 feet (2500 sq. ft to 5,625 sq. ft). The engineer should provide a scaled map showing location of the borings and depth of soil cover. Also applicable is Regulation 15 NCAC 13B .0566 (5-7), which addresses soil cover and erosion control. See the Regulations provided in the prior SWS letter, dated March 4, 2010 (Doc ID 9930). Please notify the SWS if another copy of the regulations is needed.
3. Submit a copy of the deed for the LCID property and any other documentation pertaining to the permit that is filed (i.e previous permits) with the Register of Deeds Carteret County.
4. Contact the Environmental Specialist for the site to schedule an inspection in which to determine compliance with closure procedures. The Environmental Specialist's name and contact information is listed at the end of this letter.

Following completion of the procedures above, the SWS will send a closure package. The package will include a cover letter, a copy of the audit report of your facility inspection, and a Letter of Closure. When a solid waste disposal site has been closed in accordance with the SWS requirements, the permit will be terminated. Future disposal at the site will require a new permit.
