Dear Mrs. Andrews:

In a letter dated March 24, 2010, you expressed the intent to close the above referenced facility. An email was sent to you by the Solid Waste Section (Section) on March 25, 2010 detailing further instructions on how to properly close the facility. The Section has not received any correspondence from you since that time. The referenced email is attached for our convenience. To reiterate the email, the following procedures are necessary to properly close the landfill.


1. Submit a letter of certification to the Solid Waste Section (Section), signed by a North Carolina licensed professional engineer, that a minimum of one (1) foot of suitable soil cover has been placed over the entire landfill. The engineer should take soil borings to determine thickness of the final cover. Soil borings should be on a grid, spaced every 50 to 75 feet (2500 sq. ft to 5,625 sq. ft). The engineer should provide a scaled map showing location of the borings and depth of soil cover. For further guidance, please refer to Regulation 15 NCAC 13B .0566 (5-7), which addresses soil cover and erosion control. See the Regulations provided in a previous Section letter, dated March 10, 2010 (Doc ID 9969). Please notify the Section if you need another copy of the regulations.
2. Submit a copy of the deed for the LCID property and any other documentation pertaining to the permit that is filed (i.e. previous permits) with the Cumberland County Register of Deeds.
3. Contact the Environmental Specialist, Drew Hammonds at 919.433.3351, to schedule an inspection in which to determine compliance with closure procedures.

The Section requests that the above procedures be performed within 30 days of receipt of this letter. By October 4, 2010 submit the required information. Failure to submit the information may result in enforcement action, which may include the assessment of administrative penalties of up to \$15,000 per day for each day of continued violation of any requirement of the Act, the rules, or any condition of your permit, including failure to properly apply for renewal of the permit.

Following completion of these procedures, the Section will send a closure package. This package will include a cover letter, a copy of the audit report performed by Mr. Hammonds during the final inspection of your facility, and a letter of closure. When a solid waste disposal facility has been closed in accordance with the Section requirements, the existing permit will be terminated. Future disposal at the facility will require a new permit.

Thank you for your March 24, 2010 letter indicating permanent closure of the Andrews LCID facility. In addition to Rule 15A NCAC 13B .0510, please refer to 15A NCAC 13B .0566(5) for additional closure guidelines.

In order for the Solid Waste Section (Section) to consider the Andrews site officially closed, the site must obtain a Closure Certification from a third party. This certification shall be submitted to the Section for review. Upon approval of the closure certification, Drew Hammonds will inspect the facility to determine compliance with the closure procedures. If everything is in order, Mr. Hammonds will officially declare the Andrews site closed.
