Dear Mr. and Mrs. Hill:

Per our phone conversation today (March 22, 2010), you have expressed your intention to close the existing LCID landfill. Attached are some guidelines pertaining to closure of your LCID facility:

1. Please submit a signed and dated letter by the owner of the LCID landfill to the Solid Waste Section explaining your intentions to close. This letter may be included with other documentation to close the landfill (i.e. a certification of closure by a professional engineer, mentioned below).
2. A professional engineer (P.E.) needs to approve of closure of this landfill. Applicable rules to adhere to are: 15 NCAC 13 B. 0566 (5-6-7). Also, the slopes should be adequate to prevent surface water ponding. Soil borings need to be taken by the designated P.E. engineer, every 50 feet to 75 feet (2,500 ft² to 5,625 ft²) grid to ensure a minimum of one (1) foot soil cover.
3. A copy of the deed of the LCID property and any additional documentation that has been filed [i.e. previous permit(s)] from the Register of Deeds in Davidson County. I did locate the previous permit issued December 7, 1990 and attached deed, on the Davidson County Register of Deeds web site, but was not able to print it for our records. Therefore, please request a written copy from Davidson County and any other documents associated with this LCID property. The Book Number is 759 and the Page Numbers are 801-805.
