Dear Mr. Ray:

Thank you for submitting the documentation you and Mr. Phillip Hill compiled pertaining to the closure of the Hills and Sons LCID landfill (Permit No. 29A). I received the documentation on March 29, 2010.

In your letter you mentioned in-part: "*Prescribed borings according to your applicable rules, revealed a minimum cover of 12" topsoil*". According to the previous letter to Phillip Hill and Gina Hill (dated 3-22-2010) I mentioned under condition No. 2 that soil borings need to be taken every 50 to 75 feet (2,500 ft² to 5,625 ft²) grid to ensure a minimum of one (1) foot soil cover. Please provide this documentation [via scaled drawing(s)] depicting actual boring locations and depths of soil cover.
