



SUMMARY OF COMMUNICATION

Mr. Barneycastle requested a site visit because he felt that all waste was now 100ft from property lines. A new road had been put in next to the property line where LCID waste had previously been disposed. Around 50% of the waste had been pushed back to 100ft from the property lines. However, some waste was as close as 50ft from the property line. Mr. Barneycastle was informed that all waste needs to be 100ft from the property lines, and I suggested again that he survey his property to know exactly where the 100ft buffer is located. He insisted that it would be impossible to move the rest of the material and requested to speak with Brent Rockett. I tried to call Brent from the site, but he was unavailable. I told Mr. Barneycastle that I would ask Brent to call him. While driving back to the WSRO, Brent contacted me, and I requested that he call Mr. Barneycastle. Brent called Mr. Barneycastle and left a voice mail message with for him.

In addition, LCID material was burning when I arrived. Mr. Barneycastle indicated that only the small area burning during my visit was the only material he had burned. From WSRO I called Mr. Barneycastle and left a message that he should stop burning LCID waste and should not burn anymore material.
