

Subject: GlaxoSmithKline closure of P-Building incinerator and associated solid waste permit

Dear Donna:

This correspondence is intended to provide formal notification that GlaxoSmithKline (GSK) is closing its P-Building solid waste incinerator. The facility ceased operations on August 30, 2011; no further waste incineration will occur at this unit. Thus, GSK is requesting closure of solid waste permit 32-09-I.

The current status of the P-Building is as follows: the incinerator tipping floor and warehouse waste storage are empty. The heat exchanger tubes and bags from the baghouse have been removed. Incineration wastes, consisting of ash and spent lime, are being processed for off-site disposal in accordance with applicable regulations. GSK has begun the process of housekeeping and cleaning/decontaminating the unit, which will generate additional ash and lime wastes; these waste streams also will be disposed off-site in accordance with applicable regulations. Following completion of these tasks, the incinerator and the building within which it is located will be demolished.

I understand that the Solid Waste Section will inspect our incinerator, currently scheduled for September 27, 2011, to evaluate regulatory compliance and confirm that conditions are acceptable to close the solid waste permit 32-09-I.
