Dear Sir:

An inspection of the Land Clearing Inert Debris Landfill located at Stafford Mill Road, Tax Lot 4X and 4T, Tax Block 5156, indicates that this site is no longer active.

The Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Zoning Enforcement Office and the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Erosion Control Office consider this landfill site to be permanently closed. Notice of this closure will be forwarded to the North Carolina Department of Environment, Health and Natural Resources, Division of Solid Waste Management.

Any continued operation of a landfill on this site will be a violation of Chapter B, Article II and Chapter C, Article VII of the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Unified Development Ordinance, and may result in civil penalties being assessed against you.

Since this landfill is also regulated by the State, it is imperative that you contact the North Carolina Department of Environment, Health and Natural Resources to verify that your site meets the closure regulations of that agency. Prior to reactivation of this landfill, the landowner will have to obtain required permits from the Zoning and Erosion Control sections of the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Inspections Division. The owner will also have to obtain a formal approval from the North Carolina Department of Environment, Health and Natural Resources, Division of Solid Waste Management.

On January 16, 1996 you were notified by our office that the landfill at the above address would need to meet improvement standards in order to comply with Chapter B, Article 5-4 of the Zoning Ordinance. The deadline for compliance is January 1, 1997.


This letter will serve as your second and final notice for complying with the necessary improvements prior to issuance of violation notices.

In addition, to Zoning regulations, Environmental Regulations, Chapter C, Article VII Erosion Control, of the Unified Development Ordinance requires that an Erosion Control plan be submitted to the Inspections Division and a grading permit be obtained for any Land Clearing and Inert Debris Landfill (LCID) that exceeds 10,000 square feet in area.

If your site has been closed or will be closed prior to January 1, 1997, you will need to obtain a letter of closure from the NC Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources and forward a copy of the letter to the Inspections Division at P O Box 2511, Winston-Salem, NC 27102.

Failure to comply with the regulations may result in civil penalties being assessed against property owners.

Dear Sir:

Please find attached a copy of the last inspection of your demolition landfill dated July 31, 1992.

This office must ask all operators and owners of demolition landfills to manage their incoming waste so that they only accept waste for which the site is permitted to receive.

On July 31, 1992 Permitted site No. 34-NN had accepted metals, carpet, two mattresses and one fuel tank (saddle tank from a large truck). This may be sufficient reason in the future to consider suspension or revocation of your permit. If this item is marked consecutively, during the next inspection, a "Notice of Violation" will be prepared and sent to you followed by a request for penalty assessment to the Division of Solid Waste Management, Department of Environment, Health and Natural Resources.

I strongly suggest that you contact your contractor/operator and establish complete control of waste acceptance into this site. I will reevaluate this site for compliance 30 days from the date of this correspondence.

Also, the elevations on this site were to follow the contour of Stafford Mill Road. The elevations, as installed by the contractor, currently are inconsistent with the road contour(s) therefore I would suggest that an engineer be contacted to assist in preparing a design of this site which would include: management of surface waters and interim/final elevations for this site. Upon approval of the design by this office for surface water management and final elevations your contractor/operator will need to make the necessary changes in the field reflecting the approved design for this site.

Please be advised that the above described site does not have appropriate erosion control. As owner of this site you must install a siltation control device (sediment retention pond) sized sufficiently to control erosion at this facility.


This device must be installed upon receipt of this notice. It is imperative that this device be installed immediately to protect the watershed below the landfill.

This is to notify you of this Division's intent to suspend/revoke the permit 60 days from receipt of this notice should you fail to install the appropriate erosion control devices necessary to protect the watershed. You may appeal this decision and request a hearing, by petition, to the Office of Administrative Hearings, P.O. Drawer 27447, Raleigh, NC 27611-7447, in writing within the number of days specified above of your intent to attend the hearing. If you do not petition the Office of Administrative Hearings, you waive your right to the hearing and the decision to suspend or revoke the permit is final.





6. The final slope of a demolition landfill shall be 3 to 1 unless other engineered plans are approved by the permitting agency.
7. Dust suppression shall be provided for where necessary.
8. Erosion control features shall be installed where necessary. These features shall include but not be limited to: (a) energy dissipaters, (b) silt fences, (c) straw, (d) berms, dikes, and diversion ditches, and (e) brush barrier.
9. All finished areas within six months of completion shall be stabilized at its surface with native grasses.
10. Vehicles shall not exceed a safe speed for the materials being hauled and shall be covered or secured with suitable device(s) when on the public highway.
11. All fill must upon completion stay a minimum of 15 feet from any property line, and 25 feet from any public utility. All easements and access shall be preserved to allow service, inspection, and maintenance of public utilities.
12. All kinds of containers shall be punctured, with the ends removed and crushed before going into a demolition landfill.
13. The site must/shall be inspected by the owner/operator at least once every ten (10) working days.
14. "No Unauthorized Dumping" signs shall be posted in a conspicuous place at the entrance.
15. Ingress and egress shall be controlled with a suitable device i.e., a chain, cable, or gate.
16. The site shall not be accessible unless the operator or his representative is on the premises.
17. All drainage features shall be preserved.
18. At no time shall any solid waste be disposed of in water or shall any water be allowed to accumulate above the fill materials.
19. At no time shall any part of the fill site enter the 100 year flood plain.
20. The permit is subject to review one year from date of issuance. At the time of review the permit may be renewed or cancelled depending on the condition of the landfill on the day of review.
21. Adequate cover materials shall be provided at all times but in no case shall final cover be less than 6 inches of uncontaminated soil. Generally 18-24 inches of cover material is preferred.


The slope in the bottom of the ditch shall not exceed 7.5 percent and sufficient number(s) of devices which control the inertia of water shall be installed.




The above drawings of the ditch are in reference to the lowest point of the two road tiles that will discharge into this open ditch.

The lowest point is considered as zero. Therefore, at 50 feet there is a three foot difference between the bottom of the discharge pipe and the 50 foot mark and so on out to the 150 foot mark. These points have already been staked with angle iron. Subsequently, the fill materials shall not go any further than these points of reference.

SUBJECT: The Proposed Solid Waste Land Fill Site on Stafford Mill Road

The material to be used will be: concrete, rock, waste lumber, stumps, various scrap metals, cinders, ashes, various other demolition type materials and dirt.

The fill level of these materials will not exceed the level of the road bed running parallel to the fill site. The course of the field should be about 150 feet and then taper to a managable angle. Entry will be controlled by a cable and lock. Signs are posted as stating "No Dumping Allowed." Only those who have permission will have access.

A drainage ditch will run at the edge of the state's right of way at an established level. Concerning the flow of water during heavy rains several water breaks will be employed. Some of these may be bales of straw, others may be crushed stone, concrete or rail road ties. The seeding schedule provided by the County will be followed upon completion of the fill site.

The proposed use of the land upon completion of the fill site is to be used as a possible building site or perhaps for pasture land.

Attached is a copy of the fill site area which will indicate the location of all homes, wells, watercourses, roads, industrial buildings, public or private utilities and other details regarding topography. This is sketched out to the best of my knowledge.

We will do everything possible to comply with any stipulation the County has set for us. Thank-you for your assistance and co-operation pertaining to this matter.






