The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the *Investigative Work Plan for MW-2R* letter dated November 10, 2011 (Doc ID 15569) and submitted by the Winston-Salem City/County Utility Commission for the Old Salisbury Road C&D Landfill. During the May 2011 water quality monitoring event and the subsequent June 2011 event, Benzene and Tetrachloroethene (PCE) exceeded the Groundwater Standards within groundwater monitoring well MW-2R. As a result of the confirmed groundwater exceedances, assessment monitoring is required, and the *Investigative Work Plan for MW-2R* dated August 10, 2011 (Doc ID 15323) was submitted to the Solid Waste Section.

At the request of the Winston-Salem City/County Utility Commission, a meeting was held at the Central Office in Raleigh on October 7, 2011. Based upon the discussions during the meeting and a letter dated October 10, 2011, a revised work plan was required to be submitted in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .0545 within 30 days. However, based upon the November 10, 2011 letter, the Winston-Salem City/County Utility Commission is requesting a 30 day extension of the submittal of the revised the *Investigative Work Plan for MW-2R*.
