Dear Mr. Nuss:

Several weeks ago you informed me that the BMWNC, Inc. Medical Waste Treatment Facility, Permit No. 3611 located in the City of Gastonia, in Gaston County had been closed and the equipment had been removed. Today, I called you once more to verify that the Facility has been closed and the equipment removed, and you did. As a result of our conversations Mr. Charles Gerstell and Mr. Bill Wagner of the Division of Waste Management verified that materials and equipment for the treatment and processing of medical waste appeared to have been removed from the site, and that the property and facility appeared to be clean. The Division hereby confirms that the Facility is closed and Permit No. 3611 has been placed in an Inactive/Closed status. This facility may no longer be used as a permitted solid waste management facility. In order for this property to be used as a permitted solid waste facility, in the future, the owner must have first applied to the Division for a new permit. Furthermore, the Division must have issued a new permit for the activity, in accordance with the requirements of North Carolina General Statute NCGS 130A and North Carolina Administrative Code 15A NCAC 13B.
