Dear Jackie and Vance:

On behalf of the Seaboard Group II and the City of High Point (the Parties), ERM NC, PC (ERM) is notifying the North Carolina Division of Waste Management (DWM) that we have been unable to reach an agreement with the Crutchfield family to conduct a proposed ground water extraction test of their water supply well at the Crutchfield property located north of the Site. The extraction (pumping) test was proposed to collect data needed to determine whether or not pumping of the Crutchfield water well may result in the capture of affected ground water from the Site.

ERM has met with Mr. J. T. Crutchfield and his mother at their property to explain the purpose and general method of the test. We believe that we made a good faith effort to address their questions and reservations, however, the Crutchfields were unwilling to agree to the test.
