RE: Water Quality Monitoring at Phase I and Phase II Closed Sanitary Landfill Units

Dear Mr. Blanchard,

In response to Harnett County's request for a final closure letter for the Phase I and Phase II units at the above referenced facility, Jim Barber requested that I review the water quality monitoring system for that part of the site. The area in question is southeast of the major drainage divide which bisects the facility, currently monitored by wells MW-16, MW-32, and MW-33.

Several additional monitoring wells will need to be installed in that part of the facility in order to adequately monitor the groundwater quality of the site. A final closure letter could be issued upon receipt of a plan containing proposed well locations and criteria for well construction specifications. Installation and sampling of the new wells within a specified time frame would be listed as a condition in the final closure letter.

I suggest that the County's consultants communicate with me at the Solid Waste Section, (919) 733-0692, ext. 342., in order to discuss a plan for upgrading the monitoring system.
