The Solid Waste Section has reviewed the *Request for Extension* for the *Assessment of Corrective Measures Pursuant to 15A NCAC 13B .1635* letter dated April 14, 2010 submitted by Altamont Environmental, Inc. for the Jackson County Landfill. The Solid Waste Section issued a letter to Jackson County dated March 5, 2010 regarding groundwater corrective action at the facility. The letter stated that an Assessment of Corrective Measures (ACM) Report was to be submitted to the Solid Waste Section within 90 days of receipt of the March 5, 2010 letter (June 2010) and pursuant to 15A NCAC 13B .1635. Per the request for extension letter, Jackson County did not budget for activities regarding groundwater corrective action at this facility for the 2009-2010 fiscal year. Therefore, Jackson County will not be able to submit the ACM Report until August 31, 2010. Also, Jackson County intends to implement an approved Corrective Action Plan (CAP) during the 2011-2012 fiscal year. As a result, the request is approved as described. Please submit an ACM Report for the facility by August 31, 2010.
