



**RE:** Notification of Landfill Ground and Surface Water Analyses  
Exceeding NC Standards

Enclosed is a copy of the Table of Values Which Exceed Established Standards for the Jones County Landfill. Please note that both arsenic and barium are listed as being in excess of reporting levels. The most likely sources of these contaminants are (1) arsenic from CCA treated wood or old pesticide containers; (2) barium from landfilled exterior paint containers (Barium compounds have been widely used as mold and mildew inhibitors in exterior paint.)

These materials were landfilled prior to Subtitle IV legislation in the early 1990s.
