Dear Mr. Miller:

The Solid Waste Section (SWS) received the final Corrective Action Plan (CAP) proposed for the Lenoir County Sanitary Landfill. Municipal Engineering Services Company, P.A. (MESCO) submitted a hard copy and electronic copy on September 30, 2009. The final CAP (Doc ID 8710) replaces the "draft of the revised report text" (Doc ID 7356) approved by the SWS on May 27, 2009. Per MESCO the draft CAP consisted of revised text to which current tables, plates, and appendices would be later attached. Following approval of the draft CAP, the SWS requested both a hard copy and electronic copy of the final CAP.


To date the SWS has not received a revised financial assurance mechanism that includes the cost for corrective action described in the final CAP. The current financial assurance mechanism, dated December 1, 2008, shows financial assurance for closure and post-closure but not corrective action. In its letters dated March 31, 2009 (Doc ID 6844) and May 27, 2009 (Doc ID 7553), the SWS requested this information. Corrective action described in the final CAP is the selected remedy for groundwater contamination described in the Assessment of Corrective Measures report for the Lenoir County Sanitary Landfill, dated August 30, 2007 (Doc ID 8712). Corrective action should be implemented in accordance with Regulations 15A NCAC 13B .1637 and 15A NCAC 13B .0547.

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Contingency plans presented in the CAP should be implemented if the remedy fails. Alternative corrective action should be recommended if the CAP fails.
