Mr. Kresnak:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed review of the submittal (DIN 11557) dated September 8, 2010 outlining a sub-surface assessment of the landfill. Based on this review, the schedule for completing the Closure and Post-Closure Plans is acceptable to the Section. However, the Section requires additional information on the project prior to authorizing the assessment activities. Please provide a response for each of the following:

1. A disposal plan for all waste material removed during boring and well drilling activities;
2. A plan for closing / backfilling boring locations upon completion of assessment activities;
3. Indicate if the landfill gas monitoring well be abandoned at the conclusion of the assessment activities.

Please note, the Section recommends using bentonite clay in the bottom and top of the borings in an effort to eliminate preferential pathways for stormwater runoff. Also, contrary to our earlier discussion, there will be no further input from Section hydro-geologists.
