Dear Mr. Esqueda:

This letter approves the leachate pond decommissioning plan at the above referenced facility, as contained in the October 29, 2008 plans prepared by CDM. The Solid Waste Section concurs that the changes, sampling, and decommissioning as outlined in the plan may begin. The County is responsible for obtaining approval as appropriate from the wastewater treatment plant related to the change to direct flow of leachate to the wastewater treatment plant.

The groundwater monitoring wells adjacent to the leachate pond must continue to be monitored, in accordance with the approved groundwater monitoring plan. Any proposed changes to the monitoring system must be approved by the Section's hydrogeologist.

It is our understanding that the leachate pond decommissioning plan is one portion of an application for modification that will be submitted for Closure and Post-Closure of the landfill facility. The leachate pond modifications will be included as an approved document in the future closure/post-closure permit modification.
