PURPOSE OF SITE VISIT:

Compliance Evaluation Inspection to determine compliance with regulations described at 40 CFR 261, 262, 264, 265, 268, 273 and 279. According to records, the last hazardous waste compliance evaluation was performed at the facility on July 14, 2010.


FACILITY DESCRIPTION:

Shamrock Environmental performs mobile industrial cleaning services and emergency response environmental cleanup in the area east of interstate 95 between southern Virginia and northern South Carolina. Hazardous waste collected is routed directly to the company's Greensboro facility and consequently, no hazardous waste is stored at this site. The company made that decision a couple of years

into opening their New Bern operation and as a result have not historically been a small quantity generator of hazardous waste. In 2010 Mr. Dick Denton advised that the facility re-notify as a conditionally exempt small quantity generator and that advice still holds. On the day of the inspection, no universal waste was observed. According to Mr. Davis, outside contractors handle vehicle and facility maintenance including management of used lamps and batteries. Used oil management practices at the facility are in compliance.

SITE DEFICIENCIES / RECOMMENDATIONS:

No site deficiencies were noted or observed. Recommend the facility re-notify as a conditionally exempt small quantity generator.
