STATUS OF PAST NOTED VIOLATIONS:

None

AREAS OF CONCERN AND COMMENTS:

1. The facility has a service area of Alexander County only.
2. The facility receives approximately 145 tons of waste per month.
3. This audit was a partial inspection to observe the operations of the facility.
4. The working face of the C&D landfill was small and compact. The area was less than one-half acre in size.
5. No unacceptable waste streams were observed within the working face at the time of inspection.
6. One tire was observed to the side of the working face that had been removed from the waste stream. Continue efforts to remove unacceptable waste streams as they are observed.
7. Operational cover was good at the time of inspection. However, some slight washing of the soil was observed on the southern, inactive slope of the landfill at the time of inspection resulting in some waste being exposed. This area must be repaired by covering the area with a minimum of 6-inches of earthen material.
8. Windblown waste was well managed at the time of inspection.
9. All access roads were well maintained and accessible at the time of inspection.
10. Appliance had recently been picked up for removal. Gavel has been installed at the appliance area over fabric to stabilize the area.
11. The tire collection area was well managed at the time of inspection. All tires were located in trailers and covered.
12. Electronics are being accepted at the facility and placed onto pallets and into bins for recycling purposes. This area was well managed at the time of inspection. All electronics are picked up by Creative Recycling System.
