A Permit to Operate was issued on December 22, 2005 and expired on January 15, 2008

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
**STATUS OF PAST NOTED VIOLATIONS:**

None

**AREAS OF CONCERN AND COMMENTS:**

1. The facility has a service area of Alexander County only.
2. The facility receives approximately 166 tons of waste per month.
3. The permit was reviewed and was current. However, the current Operations Plan could not be located at the time of inspection. Mr. Mitchell has recently moved offices. A copy of the Operations Plan must be located and maintained on site.
4. Groundwater monitoring was being performed semi-annually as required.
5. Methane monitoring was being performed quarterly as required.
6. Waste screening reports were reviewed. Be sure to document what actions are taken to properly dispose of unacceptable waste streams when they are discovered.
7. Certified Landfill Operations Specialists:
  - Freddie Mitchell (expires 3/27/13)
  - Ray D. Story (expires 2/13/12)
  - William Shook (expires 3/19/13)
8. The working face of the C&D landfill was small and compact. The area was less than one-half acre in size.
9. No unacceptable waste streams were observed within the working face at the time of inspection.
10. Three tires were observed within the working face at the time of inspection. However, Mr. Mitchell removed all tires prior to the end of the inspection. Be sure to remove all unacceptable waste streams from the working face when observed.
11. Operational cover was good at the time of inspection. However, some slight washing of the soil was observed on the northwest, inactive slope of the landfill at the time of inspection. This area must be repaired by covering the area with a minimum of 6-inches of earthen material.
12. Windblown waste was well managed at the time of inspection. Wind fence had been installed along the eastern perimeter of the landfill.
13. Reviewed the soil cover records during the inspection. It appeared that operational cover was being provided weekly as required.
