Yard Waste area. Less than a half acre affected. About 6 inches around the top of the yard waste pile was burned

Gates, no trespassing signs, Nash County Sheriff's Department have keys to the landfill gates.
Also, we have yard waste sectioned off and not in just one pile.

We at present have the yard waste dumped in sections to prevent fire from spreading in the event of a fire.
