Dear Mr. Adams:

The Permit for Renewal Alleghany County Transfer Station Facility Site and Operation Plan has been reviewed. During the review several issues were noted requiring additional information or revision. The items are as follows:

- 1) Section IV. Facility Description states 3RC is a 'licensed septage hauler'. It is our understanding 3RC is not a licensed septage hauler. If this is incorrect, please provide documentation on the license status of 3RC.
- 2) Section VI. Operations Plan states the "facility receives concrete debris as well, and it is stored in a designated area". The word 'stored' indicates the concrete debris is held on site temporarily and moved later for disposal. Please revise the wording if the concrete debris is being permanently disposed of on site.
- 3) Section VI. Operations Plan sub-section F. Hazard and Nuisance Control states litter is "picked up and discarded as needed". If there is an actual frequency, such as daily, please specify in the plan.
