PURPOSE OF AUDIT:

Inspection of Solid Waste Transfer Facility and check on the NOV compliance.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION(S) (citation and explanation):

None

You are hereby advised that, pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$5,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Statute or Regulations. If the violation(s) noted here continue, you may be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

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STATUS OF PAST NOTED VIOLATIONS (List all noted last audit):

15A North Carolina Administrative Code 13B .0201 (a) States: No person shall establish or allow to be established on his land, a solid waste manage facility or otherwise treat, store, or dispose of solid waste unless a permit for the facility has been obtained form the division.

Yancey County and Mitchell County was in violation of 15A North Carolina Administrative Code 13B .0201(a) in that they had stored, at the Yancey and Mitchell Counties' Transfer Facility, land clearing wood waste (limbs, stumps, and trunks), and in a separate pile have stockpiled pallets mixed with trash, without obtaining a permit.

Yancey and Mitchell County have removed all the landclearing wood waste, the stock pile of pallets, the trash and other debris mixed with the pallets. The site is clean, graded and in compliance. ***Violation has been corrected.***

AREAS OF CONCERN AND COMMENTS:

1. A Disaster Debris Management site must be established prior to accepting storm debris in the future.

Transfer Facility

2. This facility handles an average of 70 tons per day.
3. The leachate collection system was repaired and in operational condition.
4. The trench drain appeared to have been recently cleaned.
5. All waste on the tipping floor was loaded into the trailer during the inspection.
6. Windblown litter surrounding the building was picked up.

White Goods Collection Area

7. Metals were loaded from the metal tipping area into the trailer.
8. Fuel tanks were being separated for recycling.
9. The scrap metal loading floor needs to be cleaned periodically.

Other Areas

10. The Transfer Facility Permit needs to be modified since a new company is operating the facility and receiving the waste at another Landfill.
