RE: Western Portion Construction & Demolition Debris Landfill -- Buncombe County Expansion.

A rock comparison study was completed for the western portion of the construction and demolition (C&D) landfill. The study confirms consistency with the lineament trace study for measured dips and fractures. Any faulting observed is minor and does not require any additional monitoring. A previously noted lithologic contact in an early report near the western portion of the C&D is actually variability in the rock fabric.

The report completely addresses the issues raised for the western portion of the C&D area and satisfies the conditions of the geologic review for Phase II. As required in the Phase I portion of the C&D cell, Phase II rock pinnacles are to be covered with four feet of fill.
