Dear Mr. Herman:

A meeting was held at your office on April 10, 2008 regarding information required to continue processing your application for a new land clearing and inert debris (LCID) landfill. During this meeting we discussed the need for additional information the City of Newton would need to submit. As requested, corrected design plans and details were submitted shortly after the meeting by Al Stewart with W.K. Dickson. In addition, the City was asked to submit the following information:

- 1) Documentation proving the waste will be at least 4 feet above the seasonal high water table
- 2) Meets and bounds for the landfill area including the required buffer of 100 feet
- 3) Updated operation plan including estimates of the quantity of waste to be received

I have received documentation for items 1) and 2) from Alex Fulbright. However, I have still not received the updated operation plan as requested. Please forward this information to my attention as soon as practicable. The permitting process for the proposed LCID landfill cannot proceed without receipt of the required documents.
