The permit is dated March 7, 2011 and includes the PTO for Phase 1, Cells 1 and 2 and the Permit to Construct (PTC) for the remaining cells in Phase 1, Cells 3 and 4. Read your permit carefully. You should note Attachment 2, Part I, Condition No. 6.c. requires you to contact me or Mr. Charles Gerstell, Division Senior Environmental Specialist, to determine whether the Section chooses to hold a pre-operative meeting with key landfill personnel. The typical pre-op meeting is held approximately two (2) weeks prior to commencement of landfill operations.
