Thank you for the time and assistance you gave me last week during your site visit. I will reply soon with detailed plans that address the concerns you raised. Those areas needing our attention are:

- Improved lines of communication.
- There must be some form of retention system (knee wall or berm made with material that will not wash away with flowing liquids or melted rubber.
- Restricted access using fencing, gates, and signs.
- Removal of solid waste, litter, and trash.
- Validate the Operations Plan is implemented completely as described in the current Permit to Construct.
