

Dear Mr. Arthur:

The Solid Waste Section has been requested to comment on the types of waste which can be disposed of in the Arrington Demolition Landfill Permit #19-A in Chatham County.

The waste types are limited to what is specified under the permit conditions; i.e., limbs, leaves, stumps, concrete, brick, wood and uncontaminated earth.

Questions have arisen concerning small incidental pieces of asphalt which may be mixed in with the waste. As long as the asphalt consists of less than 1% by volume of each waste load, it will be considered incidental and therefore, allowable.

Dear Mr. Womble:

I have reviewed the information provided by Dan Brubaker with Philip Post and Associates concerning mining on 58.5 acres of your property on the west side of U.S. 15-501 in Baldwin Township. The property is listed on property records as parcel identification number 9776-35-6242.

It appears from the affidavit provided that the use of the property for surface mining meets the definition of a non-conforming use. The limit of the non-conforming use is the area of approximately 6.13 acres shown on a map dated May 20, 1991, entitled "Preliminary Mine Map Arrington Mine", by Philip Post & Associates. A copy of Section 9 of the Chatham County Zoning Ordinance which addresses non-conforming situations is enclosed.
