Dear Mr. Hester:

Attached is a Permit to Construct and Operate the above referenced facility issued to you in accordance with N.C.G.S. 130A-294 and the N.C. Solid Waste Management Rules 15A NCAC 13B .0201(b)(2). The Permit is issued for a period of 5 (five) years. At least 30 (thirty) days prior to the review date shown in the permit, you must submit an application for review of the facility and operations, and demonstrate substantial compliance with the Permit to Operate, the approved Facility Operating Plan, the N.C. Solid Waste Management Rules, and all other applicable rules and laws. Failure to demonstrate substantial compliance will require you to properly remove and dispose of all wastes from the site in advance of the permit expiration date.

Also included with the permit is Attachment 1 that lists the documents included in the approved plan. The approved facility description includes the area described in the legal description contained in the approved Operation Plan. The approved facility is permitted for transferring construction debris at the facility shown in the Appendix D drawing in the approved Operations Plan.

In addition to the other conditions contained in the Permit, please take note of the following important points relating to the operation of the facility:

1. The facility is only permitted to accept, process and transfer C&D waste materials, which is narrowly and specifically defined in the N.C. General Statute 130A-290(a)(4) as


'...solid waste resulting solely from construction, remodeling, repair, or demolition operations on pavement, buildings or other structures, but does not include inert debris, land-clearing debris or yard debris.'

2. The acceptance of any material other than C&D wastes in excess of de minimis quantities is prohibited.

3. The total quantity of waste and recovered material on-site at any time is limited by the amount of material used as the basis of the Financial Assurance.
4. Before the facility may accept waste as a transfer station under the attached permit, you must satisfactorily complete the following steps:
 - a. Facility construction must be completed in accordance with the Facility Permit Application listed in Attachment 1 of the permit (Doc Id No. 901).
 - b. Arrange for a pre-operation meeting with Drew Hammonds, Solid Waste Section Waste Management Specialist at the DENR Fayetteville Regional Office, (910) 433-3350.

Please review the Permit Conditions thoroughly and contact me at (919) 508-8498 should you have any questions regarding the Permit to Construct and Operate. Thank you for your cooperation and patience in this matter.
